**Comment 2:** Definition of 'Contact': relation of CDCs with government and nongovernmental entities to share their problems or needs through conducting meetings and getting their support.

**Comment 3:** Definition of 'Representation': the CDC has been voted for and is elected by the community to be the trusted and eligible entity in the community to make decisions on their behalf and to speak for the community inside the community itself and to the outside government/other entities in development issues.
